ACCUPLACER/SAT SCORE PLACEMENT in ENGLISH

SAT composite evidence-based reading and writing score: 610 or higher = ENGL101N or ENGL110N (see score breakdown below)

Below 610: Student must take Sentence Skills AND Writeplacer Sections of the Accuplacer for placement in ENGL101N Co-requisite Workshop OR ENGL090N Adult Learning Center; current Accuplacer scores will apply for placement.

SAT Essay (Optional): Note: If no SAT essay score is available, the prospective student will take the Writeplacer section (essay) of the Accuplacer.

If the student has SAT Essay score:

8 = ENGL110N

6-7= ENGL101N (Note: For a high SAT composite score together with an Essay score of 7: multiple assessments may be employed 1) using high school transcript grades of B+ or higher in AP or Honors English **and** 2) SAT composite score for option of ENGL101N or ENGL110N with approval of Honors program coordinator).
